Ibuprofen Dosage Table for Fever and Pain (i.e., Motrin®, Advil®)

- May be given every 6 hours.
- Do NOT exceed more than 4 doses in 24 hours.
- We do not recommend Ibuprofen for children under 6 months of age.
- If possible, use weight to dose; otherwise use age. Always ask a healthcare provider which product is right for your child.

mL = milliliter tsp = teaspoonful mg = Milligram

36-47 lbs	4-5 years	7.5 mL (1 ^{1/2} tsp)
48-59 lbs	6-8 years	10 mL (2 tsp)
60-71 lbs	9-10 years	12.5 mL (2 ^{1/2} tsp)
72-95 lbs	11 years	15 mL (3 tsp)
