







Acetaminophen Dosage Table for Fever and Pain (i.e., Tylenol®, Feverall®, Tempra®)

- May be given every 4 hours as needed.
- Do NOT exceed more than 5 doses in 24 hours.
- If possible, use weight to dose; otherwise use age. Always ask a healthcare provider which product is right for your child.

mL = milliliter
tsp = teaspoonful
mg = Milligram

Liquid Acetaminophen for Children 160mg (in each 5mL or 1 tsp)

6-11 lbs	0-3 months	1.25 mL (1/4 tsp)
12-17 lbs	4-11 months	2.5 mL (1/2 tsp)
18-23 lbs	12-23 months	3.75 mL (3/4 tsp)
24-35 lbs	2-3 years	5 mL (1 tsp)

36-47 lbs	4-5 years	7.5 mL (1½ tsp)	
48-59 lbs	6-8 years	10 mL (2 tsp)	
60-71 lbs	9-10 years	12.5 (2½ tsp)	
72-95 lbs	11 years	15 mL (3 tsp)
